Purpose

The purpose of this website is to educate users of a British musician, James Marriott. The information varies from his personal life, music he has made, and places he has toured to. This website shows images of him, his song covers and more, information on the topic (album info, info about him, etc), and links for more information. This website is perfect for educating users on James Marriott.

Potential Users

This will be helpful for people who want some background/overview on James Marriott. This website can be used by any age (realistically 11+).

Requirements

To ensure my website is fit for purpose, there will be three requirements that need to be addressed to meet the users needs. Firstly, one requirement is that the information needs to be easy to find and access. Some examples of this are, clear hyperlinks, and simple layouts. These features will make the website better because it allows the user easily access the information they need without any problems. Secondly, the next requirement will be that the colours have to be linked to the theme. For example, if the website was ocean themed the colours will be a mix of blues and greens. This is because it makes the website aesthetically pleasing for the user to look at and doesn't make my website unpleasant while still being suitable for people vision disabilities which leads into my third requirement. Lastly, the third requirement is making the website accessible to anyone with disabilities like; colour-blindness or partial blindness. This can be achieved by making the text and background colours contrasting, and the text larger (For example: size 16, or F2). It makes my website usable by anyone and everyone. If these requirements are met it will make my website easy to access and fit for purpose.

Specifications (These are measurable)

Requirement #1: Information needs to be easy to find and access

Specifications:

- The website will have a simple and clean layout
- The hyperlinks will clear and easy to find

Requirement #2: Colours have to be linked to the theme

Specifications:

- The colours are in the same 'value scale' eg: blue, and purple
- The colours help the text be easy to read

Requirement #3: The website is accessible to anyone with disabilities like; colour-blindness or partial blindness

Specifications:

- At least two colours that are colour-blind friendly
- Font size at 16 or above so it's easy to read

- Images of his previous stages)

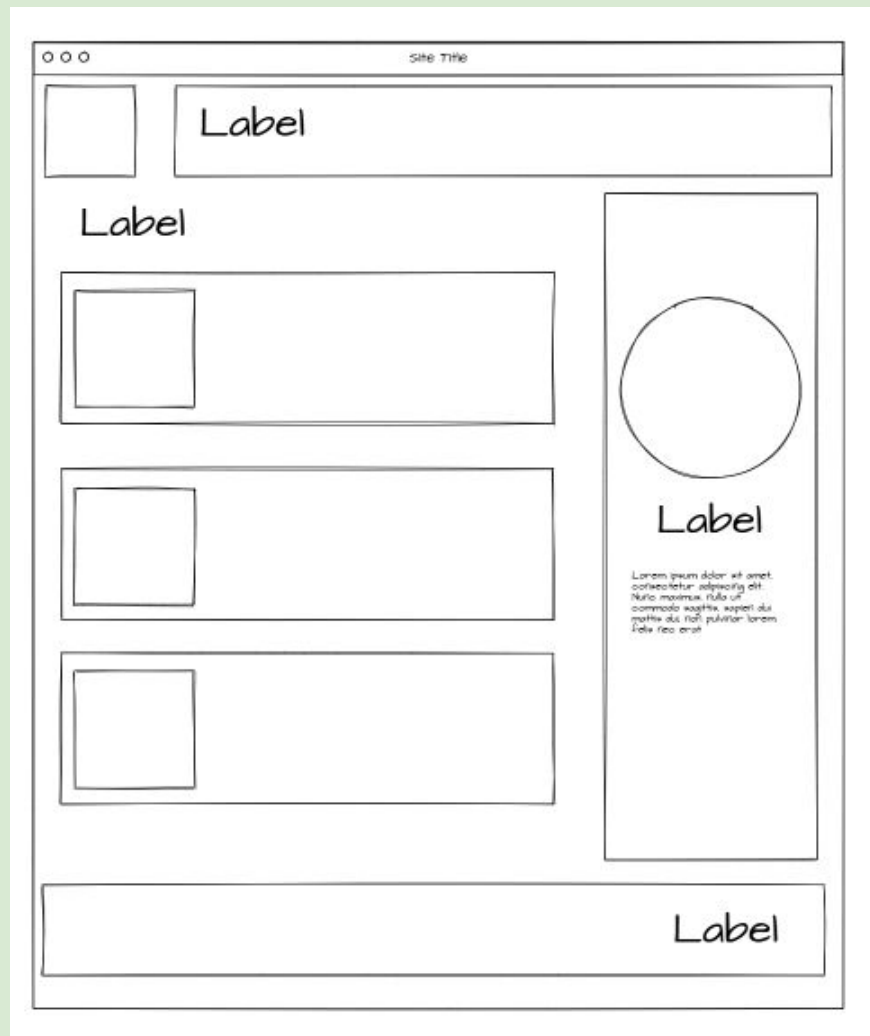

Research

I have found multiple methods to help people with impaired vision/colour blindness access the information on my website. One of the methods is making the colours highly contrasting instead of colour matching. This is so that people with either colour blindness or impaired vision can easily read the information without having any difficulties. Another method method is making the layout simple and easy to understand by avoiding putting in to many columns and making the website clutter. It helps people with either colour blindness or impaired vision access information easily and that they don't have to zoom in as much to read the information. One more method that I found is that I can add audiobooks and podcasts to my website. This can be extremely useful for people with either colour blindness or impaired vision to consume the information without even having to read. If I add these methods to my website, it will make it more accessible to anyone especially those with either colour blindness or impaired vision.

Tools and Techniques

- One of the tools I used to create my website was Visual Studio Code. This helped me write in my code to create my website and kept my code all in one place.
- Another tool that I used which ties in with the first tool is Visual Studio Code functionality: e.g. auto-completion, selecting colour. This helped me make sure there was no errors and that the code was written correctly as well as quickly.
- The third tool I used was the HTML & CSS validator. This tool made sure that my code was correct and if it wasn't it showed me what was wrong making fixing my code easy.
- The fourth tool I used is Photoshop to resize my images to the appropriate size for the website

Fit for Purpose:

My completed website has been tested multiple times, improved, and fixed multiple times and now meets the purpose and user requirements. The first improvements I made was recropping one of the photos and editing the text to be bolder for the navigation buttons. Making the text bolder may help people with vision impairments to see the text easier, making my website accessible to everyone, while recropping the single: "Slow Down" image made my website cleaner and nicer to look at. Two more improvements I made was changing the colour of the nav bar to a darker shade of blue, and the side bar colour matching the nav button colour. The colour of the nav bar now matched the rest of the bars and didn't look like it blended into the background, adding more contrast to the website, especially for people with vision impairments. Changing the colour of the side bar to match the nav buttons was not a good idea because the colours did not look good on the website and did not match the blue theme, causing me to change it back to it's original colour. One more improvement I made which was requested by Julio was adding a fourth page. This is simply because I forgot to add one and it was a requirement to have four web pages for your website. Making these changes made my website meet the purpose and user requirements.
